WARWICK TOWNSHIP BOARD OF SUPERVISORS NOVEMBER 3, 2021 MINUTES

Chairman Swinehart called the Regular meeting of the Board of Supervisors to order, 7:00 p.m. at the Township Municipal Building, Mr. Swinehart, Mrs. Cameron, Solicitor Crotty and Mr. Boulanger were present. Mr. Sydlosky was absent.

Chairman Swinehart made a motion to approve the minutes of the October 5, 2021 meeting with two spelling errors corrected, 2nd Mrs. Cameron, 2 ayes.

Mr. Swinehart stated an Executive Session was held on October 25, 2021, noon to discuss legal matters.

Mr. Swinehart made a motion to approve the Treasurer's report for the General, State and Open Space funds as submitted, 2nd Mrs. Cameron, 2 ayes

CITIZENS REQUEST OR COMMENTS - Several citizens would like to see a trail or something named after Charles Jacob.

REPORTS

ZONING OFFICER - Mr. Boulanger reported on Zoning activities. He issued 4 building permits in October and continued to work on zoning violations for 2448 N. Hill Camp Road; Mr. Moore. Mr. Boulanger reported he visited property and the rooster is still crowing, he will issue a cease and desist. RAMA properties a Cease and Desist order will be sent, the property is still in violation. 2664 Ridge Road, Thunder Wash, the Chester County Conservation District contacted the Township about Stormwater runoff. Mr. Boulanger sent a letter and also spoke with owner Mark Cummins and he has corrected run off from behind the building but did not contact CCCD. 147 Sunrise Drive noise complaint has been resolved.

ROADMASTER - The Road crew removed trees on Northside, Rock Run, Laurel and Warwick Furnace. Cleaned all catch basins and moved Speed sign to north bound Hill Road. Completed basic maintenance of all vehicles and repaired dirt Mt. Pleasant, Trythall, Warwick, James Mill, Rt 345 and Old Ridge Roads. Black topped swale on County Park, and ditched Warwick Furnace,

N. Hill Camp, Laurel, Trythall and Dampman Roads. Repaired 1995 backhoe accelerator, replaced battery in big Red tractor. Leaf blowing was done on Chrisman Drive, Warwick Circle, Hawthorne, Buck Run, County Park, Meredith and Mt. Pleasant Roads. Trucks are ready for winter.

Supervisors reviewed a quote from Collinson to repair the Trythall bridge.

Mrs. Cameron made a motion to accept the quote from Collinson Inc. for \$5998.00 for repairs, 2nd Mr. Swinehart, 2 ayes.

PLANNING COMMISSION - At the October 20, 2021 meeting of the Commission they reviewed no plans. The Commission reviewed and recommended to the Board, adoption of the zoning Ordinance amendment to Permit and Regulate Temporary and Recurring Seasonal Uses and Structures.

Supervisors read and reviewed the letter dated October 25, 2021 recommending adoption of the Zoning Ordinance amendment.

Mrs. Cameron made a motion to authorize advertisement of the proposed Zoning Code amendment and to hold a Public Hearing at the December 7, 2021 meeting of the Board, 2nd Mr. Swinehart, 2 ayes.

HISTORICAL COMMISSION – At the October 18, 2021 meeting of the Commission they reviewed three applications. Thomas and McCafferty, 141 Hopewell Road, a Class 2 structure application to remove existing second story pergola roof and replace with new timbers. The Commission recommended a new roof Everlasting Black standing metal seam, first story addition windows replaced with Anderson 400 series. Orrs, 452 Trythall Road Class 3 structure several issues were discussed, they will return to the Commission with a complete application. Erlbaum 600 Pine Swamp Road, Class 2 structure to enclose the porch with windows and door to create a sunroom. The Commission approved. Letters were written to the Zoning Officer for McCafferty and Erlbaum.

ZONING HEARING BOARD - At the Zoning Hearing Board meeting of October 19, 2021 the Zoning Hearing Board approved the Bissinger application and postponed the Newnam application till January 31, 2021.
